**Re: Notification of Plant Closing Under The Worker Adjustment and Retraining
Notification Act and ORS 285A.516**

Dear Sir or Madam:

This letter provides the notice required by ORS 285A.516 and the federal Worker Adjustment and Retraining Notification Act (WARN), 29 U.S.C. §§ 2101, et seq., (1988), that Ohio Retail Security and Mainstreet Maintenance (the "Company") may need to implement a mass layoff for work contracted at The Lloyd Center Mall located at 2201 Lloyd Center, Portland, OR 97232.

The planned action is expected to be permanent. There are no applicable bumping rights. The expected date of the first separations will occur during the 14-day period beginning on August 17, 2013. However, it is possible that the anticipated mass layoff may take place in less than 60 days from the date of this notice if the current owner of the Lloyd Center, a business that is not related to or affiliated with the Company, chooses to cancel the contract with the Company for the services of these workers before August 17, 2013. Such an early cancellation by the facility owner would constitute business circumstances that are not reasonably foreseeable by the Company at the time that the earlier notice would have been required.

The job titles of the positions that will be affected and the number of affected employees in each position are contained in the attached Exhibit A.
