Dear Mr. Asher:

Due to the downturn in the domestic midstream oil and gas markets, Sulzer has decided to reduce the overcapacity within our new equipment manufacturing network. Sulzer Pumps (US) Inc.'s Portland, OR manufacturing facility will be closed by mid-2022. Sulzer will continue to support the midstream market and supply products historically manufactured in Portland OR, via our Americas and global network of world class plants.

This letter will serve as official notice that Sulzer Pumps (US) Inc. intends to implement a permanent layoff of employees for the manufacturing operations at 2800 NW Front Ave, Portland, Oregon, 97210 on the following schedule: July 1, 2022. The total number of employees at this location to be laid off at this time is 16. Taking into account prior layoffs, the total since the first announcement in Sept 2021 is 52.

This will be a manufacturing facility closure and layoffs will continue thru mid-2022 when the current orders in backlog are completed. Certain office-based activities at this location will continue after the manufacturing facility closure.

This letter is being provided pursuant to the Workers' Adjustment Notification and Retraining Act (WARN), Public Law 100-379. The list of job titles and the total number of employees that will be affected in each job classification is available upon request. Affected employees will be notified of the impending layoff on April 29, 2022.

There is not union representation at this facility. Company provisions for transfer, bumping or reassignment do not exist.
