RE: Notification of Plant Closure pursuant to the Worker Adjustment and Retraining Notification Act of 1988 (“WARN Act”)

Dear **Ms. Soto**:

Pursuant to the notification requirement of the WARN Act, Latitudes LLC, hereby provides notice of permanent plant closure of its facility located at 2425 NE Riverside Way, Portland, Oregon 97211. Closure related employment is expected to begin on November 4, 2022.

1. The plant closure is expected to be permanent.
2. The total number of employees to be laid off is 48. A list of the affected jobs and the names of the affected employees in each job classification is attached.
3. The affected employees are non-represented and there are not “bumping rights” available as a result of the plant closure.

Also enclosed is the WARN Notice that was made available to all of our employees today. We have also sent WARN notice to Chairperson Deborah Kafoury with Multnomah County and Mayor Ted Wheeler at the City of Portland.
