Dear Mr. Welter:

Pursuant to the Worker Adjustment and Retraining Notification Act of 1988, this letter constitutes Target Corporation's ("Target") notice to the Rapid Response Coordinator regarding its permanent closure of the T3381 store, at 939 SW Morrison St., Portland, OR 97205.

Target separately provided information to employees about the opportunity to transfer to another Target store or receive separation pay. All terminations will occur on December 30, 2023 for those employees who choose not to transfer or are not eligible for transfer. Target anticipates few involuntary terminations.

The affected employees are not represented by a union. This closure is expected to be permanent. There are no bumping rights.
