Re: Worker Adjustment and Retraining Notification ("WARN")

Dear Mr. Asher:

Pursuant to the notification requirements of the Worker Adjustment and Retraining Notification Act of 1988 ("WARN"), Microsoft hereby provides notice of a layoff, and further provides notice of an anticipated schedule of additional position eliminations leading to a plant closure. This notice follows and is related to Microsoft's notices on July 10, 2017 and November 6, 2017, in which we notified you of the elimination of 61 and 50 positions, respectively.

Microsoft has decided to reorganize and restructure operations resulting in the elimination of an additional 6 positions located at Microsoft's Wilsonville, OR facility located at 26755 SW 95th Ave., Wilsonville, OR 97070. All 6 additional positions are being permanently eliminated as of February 3, 2018. Microsoft has provided all 6 affected employees with Worker Adjustment and Retraining Notifications. All affected employees will be terminated on February 3, 2018. A list of all affected job titles and the number of individuals affected in each job title is enclosed as part of Attachment A.

Microsoft's decision to eliminate 6 positions located at the above referenced facility is final and is expected to be permanent. The identified facilities will not be closed at this time. The affected employees are not entitled to an opportunity to "bump" or trade places with individuals who are not affected by the decision.

As a further anticipated schedule, Microsoft plans to eliminate additional positions at the above-referenced facility, with position eliminations scheduled to occur on or after January 22, 2018 and all affected employees to be terminated on March 23, 2018. A current list of all affected job titles and the number of individuals anticipated to be affected in each job title is enclosed as part of Attachment B. This list is subject to change if, for example, individuals voluntarily leave employment in the interim. The affected employees are not entitled to an opportunity to "bump" or trade places with individuals who are not affected by the decision. These eliminations will result in the closure of the facility. The decision to eliminate these positions and close the facility is final and is expected to be permanent.

On December 5, 2017, Microsoft sent notice via hand delivery (or overnight courier and email if not present in person) to all affected employees. Notice was also sent to the City of Wilsonville and Clackamas County for affected worksites on December 5, 2017.
