Re: WARN Act Notice: Union Pacific Hinkle Yard

In an effort to provide for Union Pacific's long-term success, the railroad has been accelerating its continuous improvement plan and implementing Precision Scheduled Railroading principles. As a continuation of our efforts to run an efficient railroad consistent with our Unified Plan 2020 program, we are undertaking operational changes across our system. As a result of these operational changes, we have concluded that as many as 195 positions will be abolished at Union Pacific's Hinkle Yard and its Supply Warehouse and Mechanical Locomotive Shop. Therefore, Union Pacific is providing you this notice in accordance with the Worker Adjustment and Retraining Notification (WARN) Act.

- 4. It is expected that affected employees will be laid off commencing on May 21, 2019, but no later than July 19, 2019.
