Dear Employment Development Department,

The purpose of this notice is to formally let you know that due to unforeseen business circumstances related to a significant decline in business due to COVID-19, HMSHost will be conducting a mass layoff at the Portland International Airport. We are giving you as much notice as possible under these unforeseen circumstances. It is expected that approximately 32 other associates will be placed laid off between March 18, 2020 and April 1, 2020, but most likely at the close of business on March 18, 2020. Currently, we expect the closing to be temporary.
