Dear Mr. Asher:

Adventist Health/West ("Adventist Health") will be eliminating the job functions and positions from Adventist Health at its facilities listed on the attached Schedule A. Consistent with these plans, employment separations from Adventist Health are expected to begin on or about May 5, 2020. Approximately two employees are expected to be separated from employment with Adventist Health. We anticipate that these changes will be permanent.

Due to the natural disaster and unforeseeable business circumstances of COVID-19, Adventist Health provided notice as as soon as practicable. This layoff is expected to be both permanent/temporary effective May 5, 2020.

Bumping rights are not available for affected employees. Affected employees are not represented by a labor organization.
