We are experiencing an unprecedented pandemic due to the worldwide COVID-19 outbreak. Statewide operational restrictions put in place by Governor Brown have resulted in a dramatic loss of business. Due to this pandemic, it is currently unknown when business will resume to normal.

This letter will serve as official notice that PCC Structurals, Inc. intends to implement a permanent layoff of employees at PCC Structurals Inc. at 4600 SE Harney Drive, Portland, OR, 97206 on or about April 15, 2020. This letter is being provided pursuant to the Workers' Adjustment Notification and Retraining Act (WARN), Public Law 100- 379.

The total number of employees to be laid off is 547. Attached you will find a list of job titles and the total number of employees that will be affected in each job classification. Some employees (below the WARN threshold) were notified of an impending layoff on April 13, 2020, and the layoff occurred on April 15, 2020. Additional layoffs based on the same circumstances are now expected to occur beginning on May 18, 2020 and continuing throughout May 31, 2020. Due to unforeseen business circumstances, PCC Structurals was unable to provide earlier notice.


