RE: Announcement of Planned Action

Dear Mr. Asher:

We are writing to give you notice that there will be a mass layoff at the ATI Albany Operations (34th Ave.) facility located at 530 34th Ave SW, Albany, OR 97322 on September 7, 2020. We are hopeful that this layoff will be temporary, but for planning purposes, all affected employees have been told to assume this is a permanent termination.

Affected employees are expected to be separated from employment beginning on September 7, 2020, with all separations accomplished by September 21, 2020.

Attached is a list of the job positions and number of individuals who will be affected by the mass layoff along with the anticipated schedule for job losses.

Represented employees will have bumping rights and may be able to displace more-junior employees at the plant. The identities of the more-junior employees who may reasonably be expected to experience an employment loss as a result of bumping are unknown at this time. There will not be any bumping rights for the remaining affected employees. That is, non-represented employees will not be able to displace more junior employees out of their job positions as a result of this action.
