## To Whom It May Concern:

This letter is to advise you in accordance with the requirements of the federal Worker Adjustment and Retraining Notification Act and any similar state or local law (collectively, the "WARN Acts") that there has been a change in the anticipated termination date of employees within your jurisdiction. To the extent that these layoffs constitute a covered event under the WARN Acts, this letter is intended to fulfill the requirements imposed under such laws, but by providing this information, David's Bridal, LLC (the "Company") does not admit that such laws apply or that notice is required.

As you are aware, on April 13, 2023, you received a WARN notice from the Company, which stated that the Company anticipates that employees within your jurisdiction will be terminated on a date between June 12, 2023, and August 11, 2023. Due to the various requirements recently imposed by the bankruptcy court, the Company now anticipates that employees within your jurisdiction will be terminated on a date between July 17, 2023, and July 31, 2023.

The information contained in this letter is based on the best information available to the Company at this time.
