Dear Coordinator Welter,

This letter is being sent to you in order to supplement the information provided on our previous WARN notification, dated February 16, 2024. Due to volume loss in our network, 19 additional UPS employees assigned to the Portland Day Sort at 6707 N Basin, Portland, OR 97217 will be separated from employment. This action is expected to be permanent due to the lack of available work at this location moving forward. Due to the reduction in volume, as of April 19, 2024, the day sort will be closed for operation. UPS remains in the above-referenced facility, but there are currently no plans to retain UPS employees assigned to the day sort beyond April 30, 2024.

Nineteen (19) part-time management employees are expected to be released on April 30, 2024.

The total affected workers at this location include 272 part-time hourly employees, 11 full-time hourly employees, 59 part-time management employees, and 8 full-time management employees. UPS will attempt to mitigate this loss by offering work to affected employees if other positions become available.

This closure will affect both union and non-union employees. Union employees are represented by the International Brotherhood of Teamsters. There are bumping rights in effect for union employees for this reduction in force, but there are no bumping rights in effect for non-union employees.

All affected employees who are covered under the Federal Worker Adjustment and Retraining Notification (WARN) Act will be given notice on an individual basis compliant with the Federal and State WARN requirements.
