Re: Notification of Employment Separation - WARN Act Notice

To Whom It May Concern:

This Notice is being provided to you pursuant to the Worker Adjustment and Retraining Notification ("WARN") Act of 1988 as applicable.

Due to a change in business needs, Zeco Systems, Inc. ("the Company") is reducing its workforce. As a result, the Company will permanently lay off certain exempt and non-exempt employees associated with supporting the media network business, contract and procurement positions, and other redundant positions in phases of separations starting October 4, 2025. These are not union represented positions, and no bumping rights exist for affected employees.

This notice is being given as soon as possible. The business circumstances leading to the reduction in our workforce affects approximately 114 employees. The job titles, the number of those affected, exit dates, and locations of employees impacted are included in the attached Exhibit A. The Company's workforce is primarily remote and spread throughout the United States; as a result, there are not 50 or more employees in any single location. The Company uses its headquarters location for purposes of filing its EEO-1 and determining which localities to notify of said separations.

We request that this information be kept confidential.
