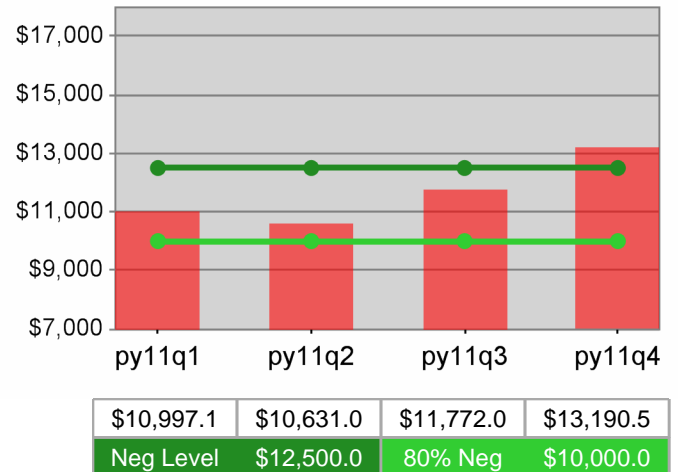
Dislocated Worker Retention



Adult Average Earnings



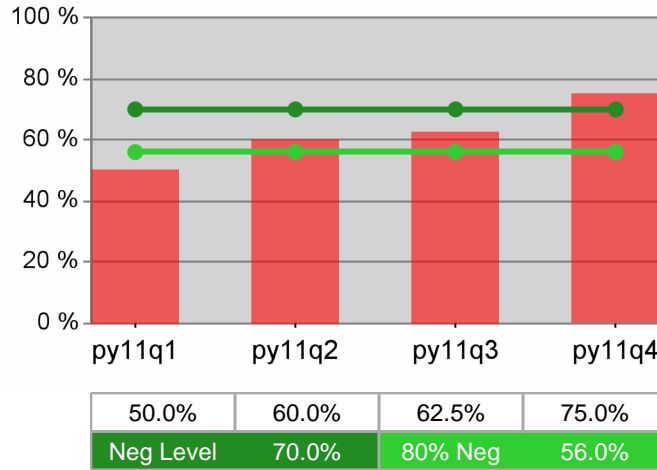

Adult Average Earnings



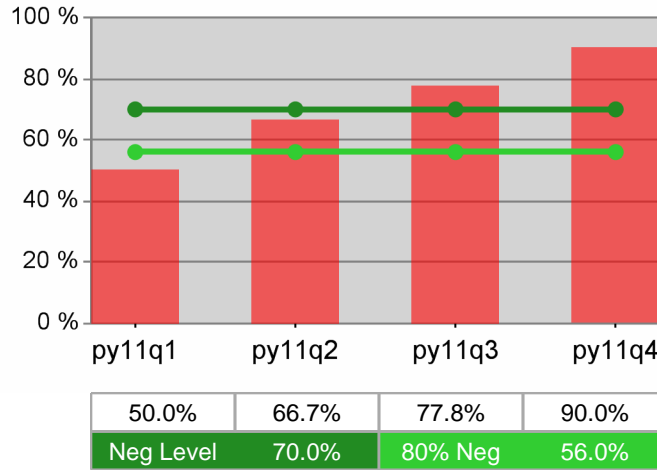
