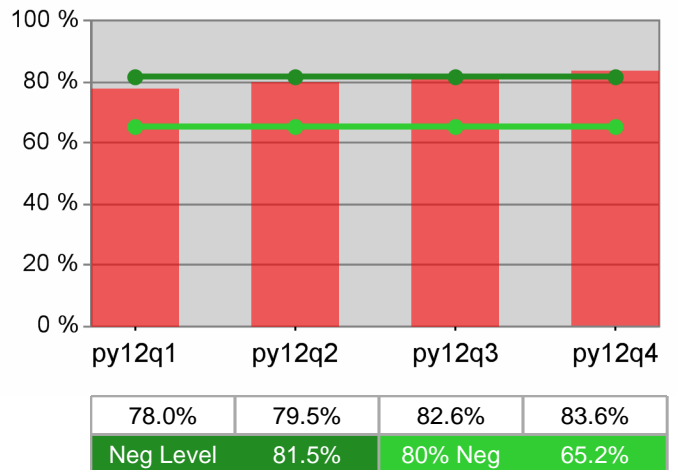
Dislocated Worker Employment



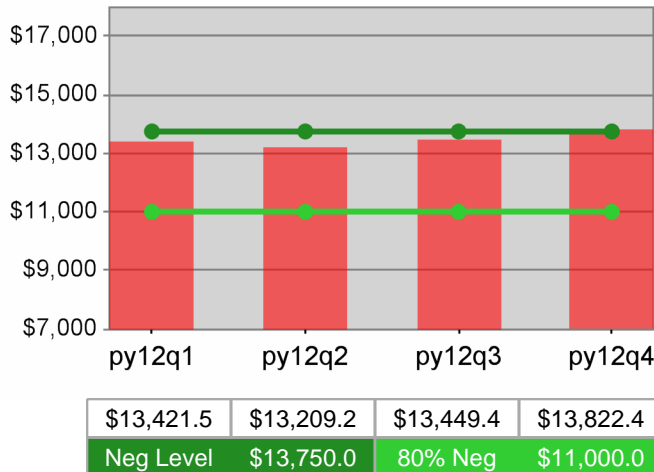
Adult Retention



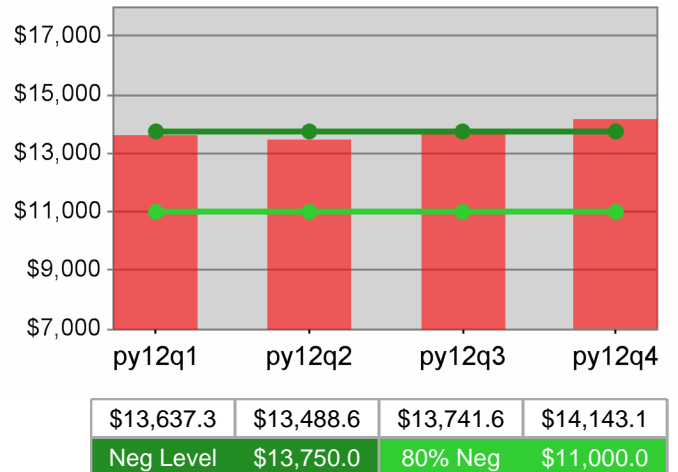

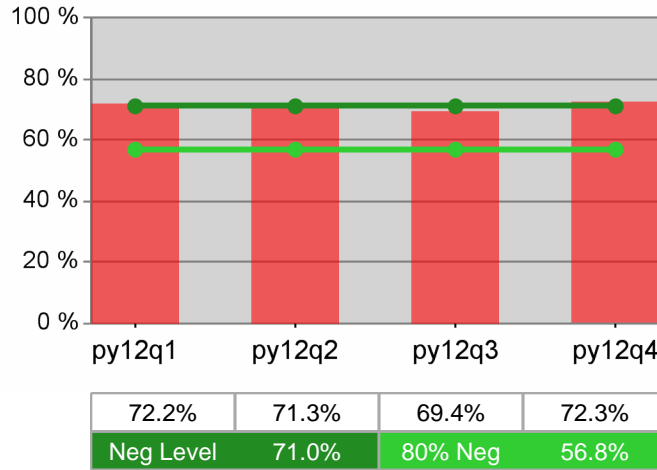


Dislocated Worker Average Earnings

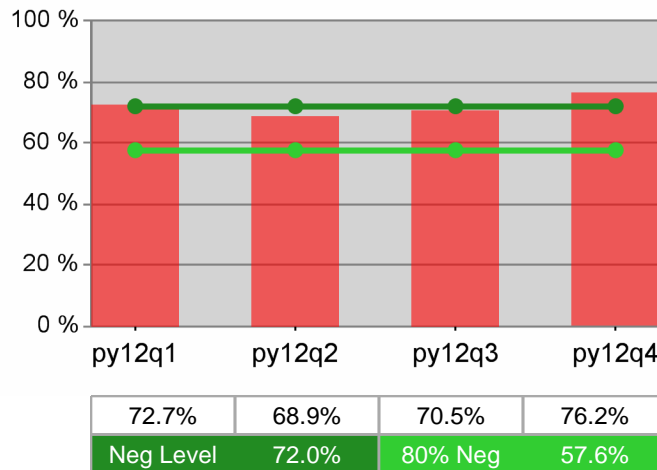

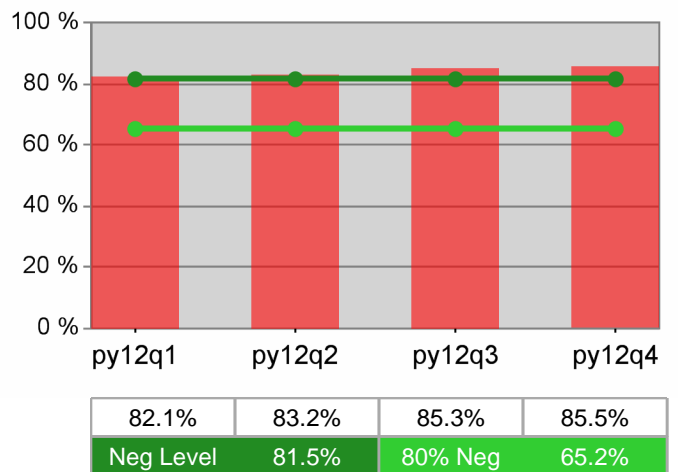
Dislocated Worker Employment



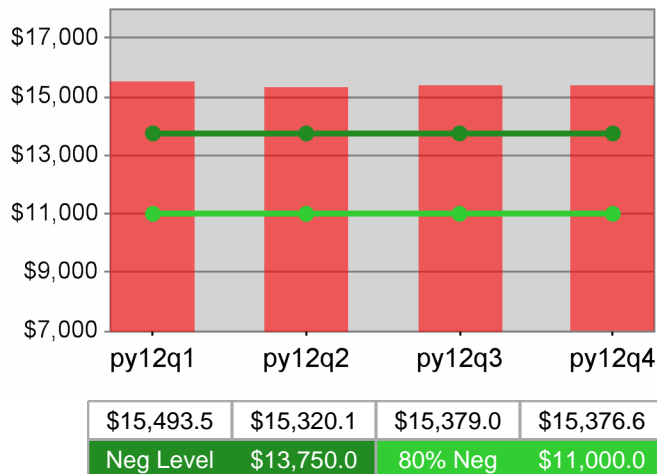

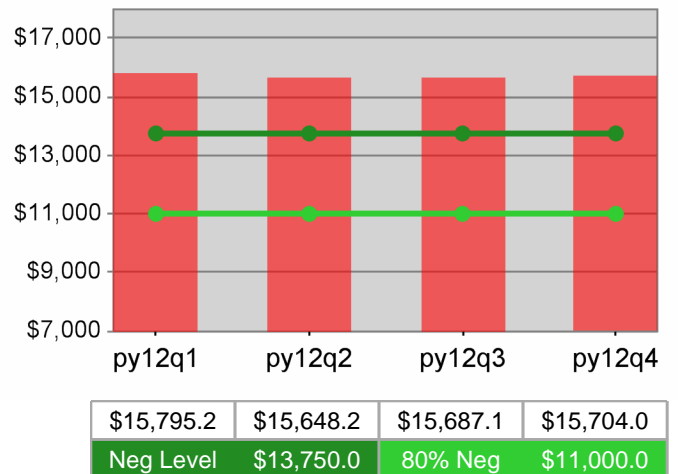

Adult Average Earnings

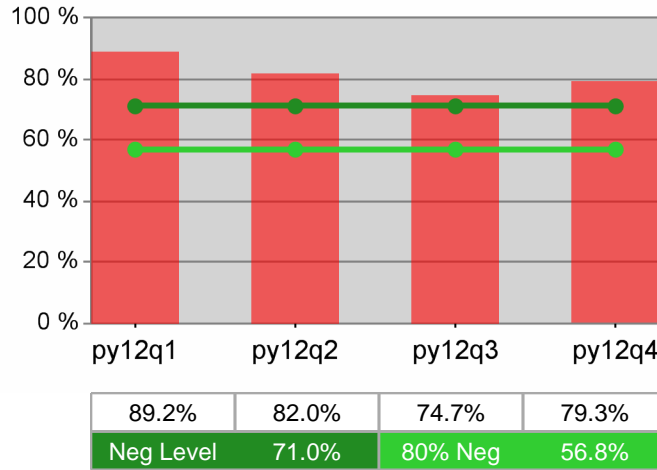


Dislocated Worker Average Earnings

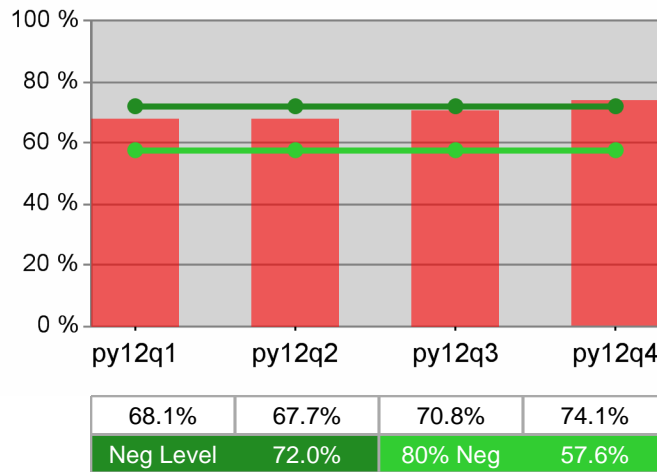

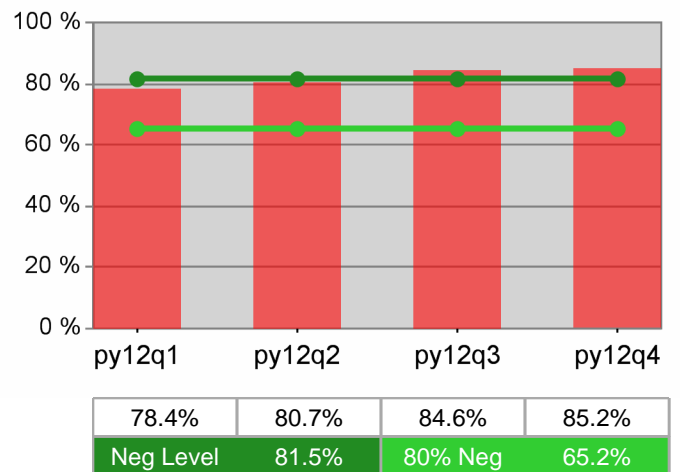
Dislocated Worker Employment



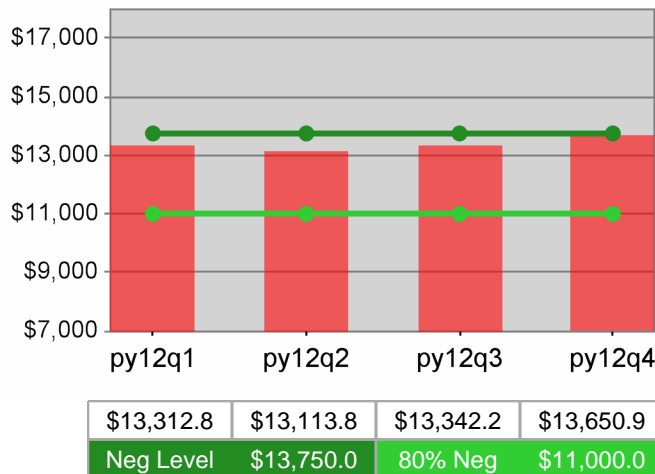
