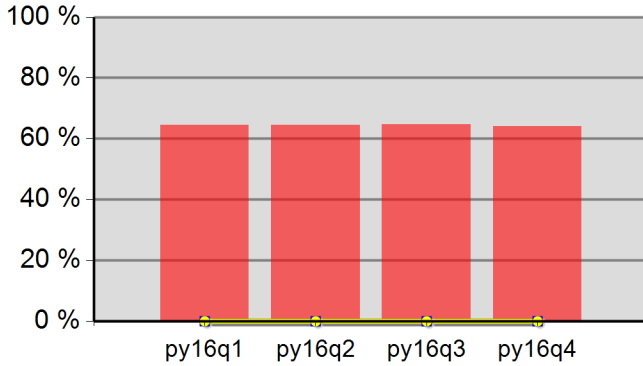

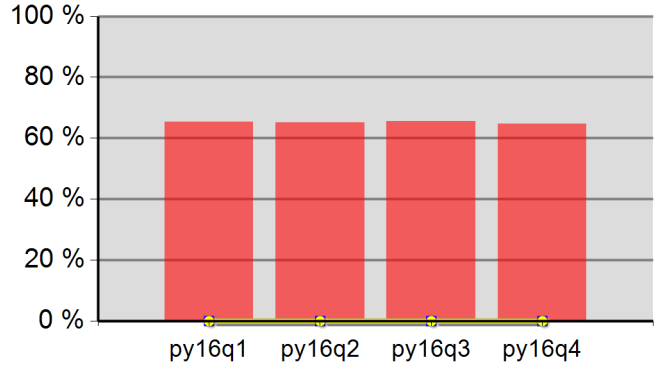

**Adult Entered Employment**



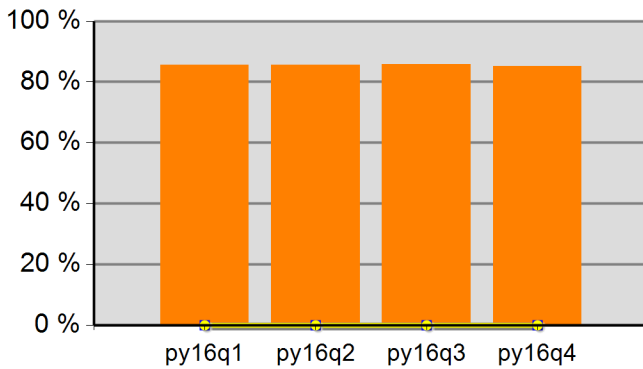

**Youth Employment or Education**



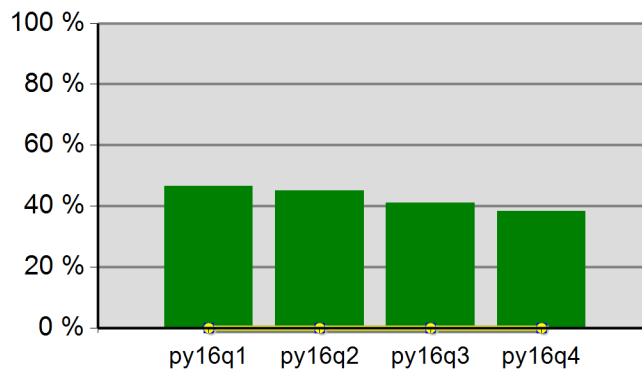

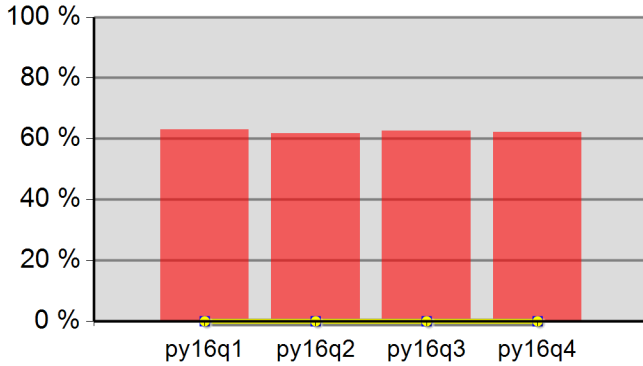

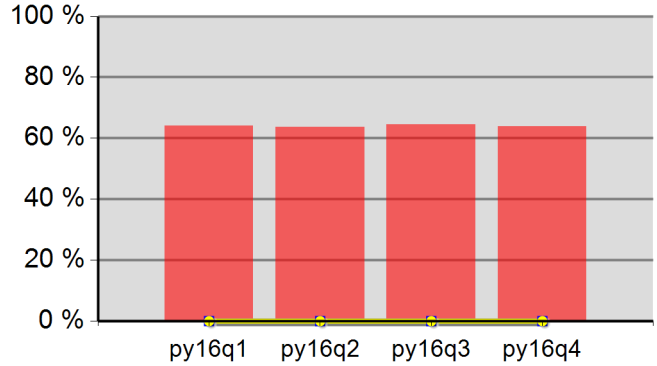

**Adult Entered Employment**



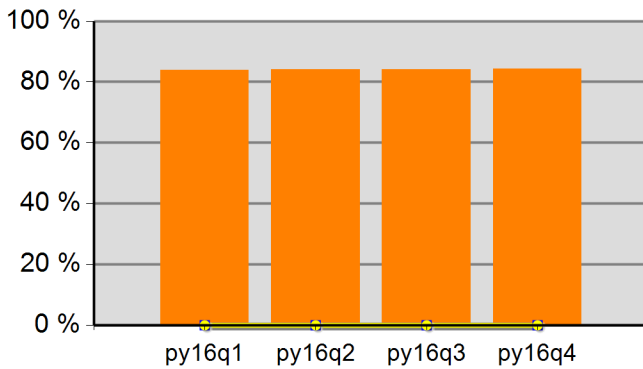

**Youth Employment or Education**



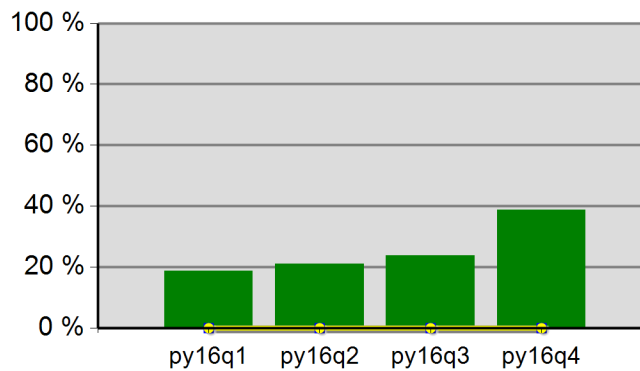

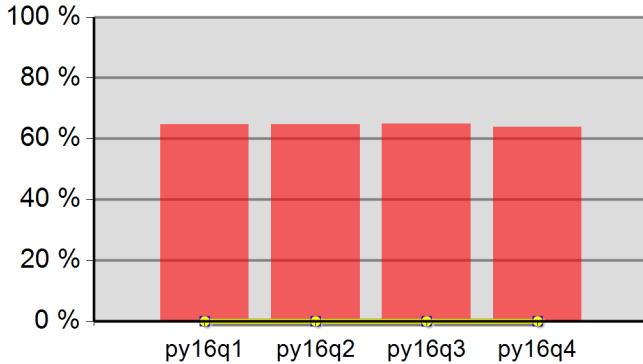

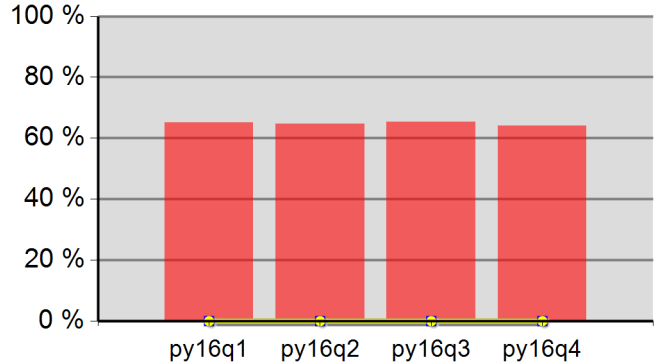

**Adult Entered Employment**



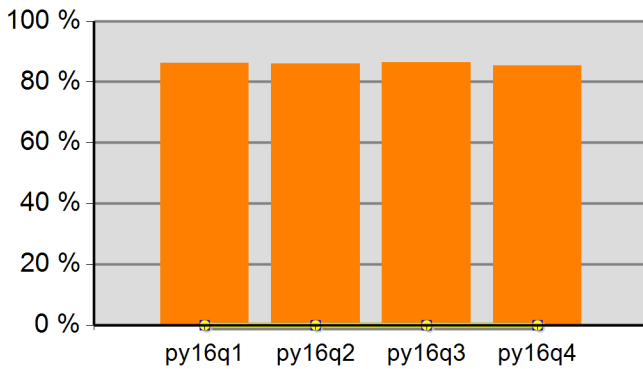

**Youth Employment or Education**



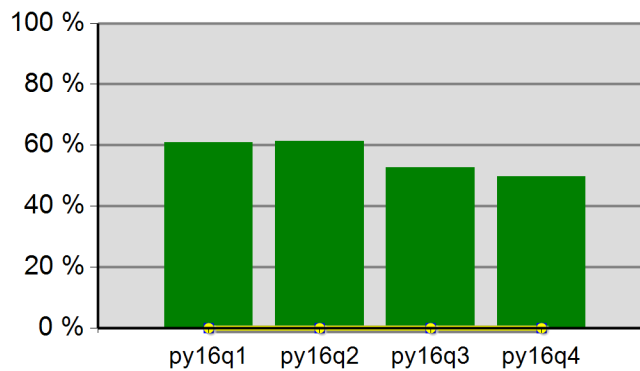

**Adult Entered Employment**



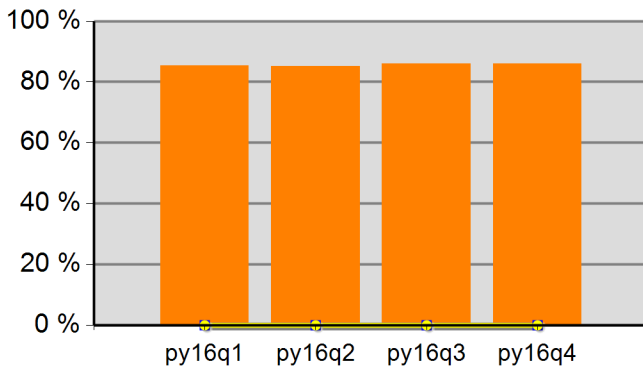

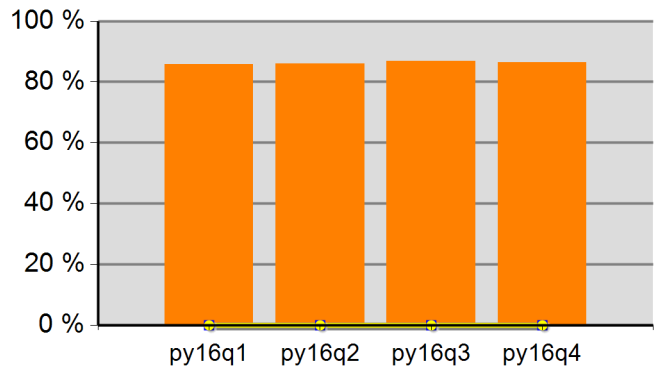

**Youth Employment or Education**



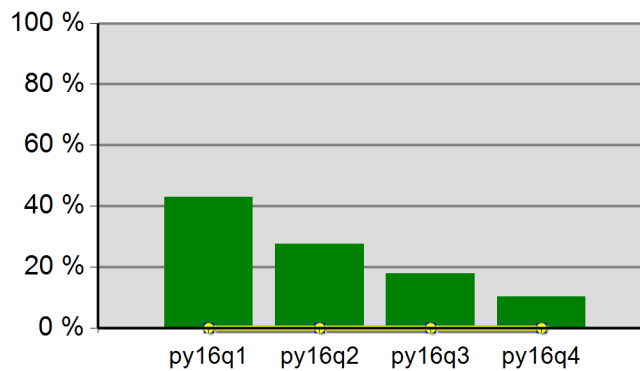
